Plans are almost finalized for a reunion in 2012 in the Memphis area. Actually, they will be finalized by the time this Newsletter is published.

As several folks may recall, during our last reunion in Las Vegas (Oct 2010), consideration was being given to having a 2012 reunion in Orlando, Atlantic City, Branson or Memphis. We had four volunteers that would investigate each place with primary considerations being ease of getting to/from our selected area, costs of rooms and reunion events (i.e., banquets, etc.) and local amenities (things to do). Orlando is able to provide us with most of our general criteria with the exception of getting a reasonable price for our hotel choice that would accommodate our needs most, so we dropped this location from consideration this time. But we got some feedback from Ken Minick who had had another reunion there and found that getting to/from airport as well as local transportation might not be to our benefit. Place: Harrah's Tunica

Cost: \$66 per night with all taxes included, PLUS **Reunion Fee** of \$85 per Person. Reunion fee is not optional (per last reunion's all-hands discussions) and includes, banquet fee, bar setup & applicable fees for the bar during the banquet, some snacks provided during the all-hands meeting, hospitality set up, and other fees Association encounters to make YOUR reunion more enjoyable.

Call: 866-635-7095 & Identify yourself as 'TD Association' reunion member.

Deadline: Reservation **MUST** be made before 7 Sept 2012 to guarantee at this rate. After 7 Sept it will be on space available basis and at prevailing hotel rates. So don't delay!

Cancel Policy: Ask at time of reservation!

Other: If enough interest, there may be a bus available to take those interested to Millington to see what's going on there today. This **COST** is **NOT** part of reunion fee and is over and above all other costs for interested parties.
