WHAT IS THE GREAT FAMILY CHALLENGE?

This unique event is similar to a scavenger hunt. Two-person teams will navigate a race course by solving clues that will lead them to various Phenix City landmarks. Teams will then complete a mental and physical challenge at each of the designated locations to earn verification of course completion. This event is designed to promote educational family fun and physical fitness.

WHO CAN ENTER?

Participating teams will consist of one adult (over 21 years of age and **MUST** be a licensed driver) and one child (5-15 years of age). **No team may consist of more than two members.**

WHERE IS THE COURSE?

The course will be within the city limits of Phenix City. **Use of a vehicle will be necessary.** Each team will be provided a map disclosing race course boundaries. Landmarks may include, but are not limited to, area businesses, public facilities and historic sites. Team check-in and the starting/ending point for the event is Moon Lake at Idle Hour Park in Phenix City, Alabama.

REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE

Preregistration is recommended. The number of teams that will be allowed to participate is limited so register early! Preregistration forms must be *postmarked by Monday, April 23, 2007.*

Preregistration entry fee is **\$25 per team**; Registration on race day is subject to availability at a cost of \$35 per team. Only teams preregistered by the deadline above are guaranteed participation in the event.

THE GREAT FAMILY CHALLENGE

RULES AND REGULATIONS

TEAMS: Each team will be comprised of one (1) parent/grandparent/adult age 21 or older plus one (1) child 5-15 years of age. Team members must be able to participate in physical tasks that may include running, lifting, climbing, jumping, etc. and be able to engage in an event that will last several hours. Each team must consist of two, and **ONLY TWO MEMBERS**. Each team is required to have **BOTH TEAM MEMBERS** in attendance at every stop along the course. At no time are teammates allowed to divide up in order to complete the race course.

REGISTRATION FEE: A preregistration fee of \$25 per team must be paid no later than April 23, 2007 and will include a t-shirt for each registered participant. Registration on the day of the event is subject to availability at a cost of \$35 per team. T-shirt choice for teams not preregistered is also subject to availability. All registration fees are non-refundable.

CHECK-IN: Check-in begins at 8:00am at Moon Lake in Idle Hour Park and will last until 8:30am. All teams must report before 8:30am or risk disqualification. The race will start promptly at 9:00am. Each participant will be issued a team number that must be worn at all times during the race and a vehicle identification card which must be displayed on the dashboard of the participant's vehicle throughout the race.

WEATHER: The Great Family Challenge will be held rain or shine. In the event of severe or dangerous weather, a decision to reschedule the race will be announced at 8:30am at check-in.

DRESS: All participants should dress in athletic attire appropriate for Spring weather in Phenix City. A Great Family Challenge t-shirt will be provided for each registered participant and **MUST BE WORN** throughout the event. Physical exertion is a part of the race. Running, jumping or walking on uneven terrain may be required, so appropriate foot wear is necessary.

LIABILITY: Participants and/or parents or guardians assume all risks and liabilities associated with participation in this event, including but not limited to, personal injury or vehicle damage. Participants and parents/guardians must sign the waiver portion of the registration form prior to application acceptance.

TRANSPORTATION: The race will require participants to travel throughout the city of Phenix City to and from locations not known until the start of the race. Reliable transportation is required. Vehicles and drivers **MUST BE INSURED**. Vehicle occupancy is limited to **REGISTERED PARTICIPANTS** only.

VEHICLE SAFETY: Race participants **MUST OBEY** all traffic laws and parking restrictions. Any participant found to be speeding or violating any traffic or parking laws will be disqualified. A vehicle identification card will be issued to each team and must be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle throughout the race.

CELL PHONE USAGE: Participants may use cell phones while in their vehicle though we discourage the use of cell phones by the driver while the car is in motion for safety reasons. Cell phone usage is **NOT ALLOWED** at race stops for any race related purposes. Violation of this rule will result in automatic disqualification.

NUTRITION: Teams are encouraged to eat an appropriate meal and to be well hydrated before the race starts. Water and snacks will be provided throughout the race. Participants should bring any other items needed.

SAFETY: Participants should check with their doctor to make sure that they are physically fit to perform physical tasks such as lifting, running, climbing, jumping, etc. and are able to perform in an event that will last several hours. Should a participant become ill during the race, a Kiwanis representative (located at each stop) should be notified immediately or call 911 if a representative is not available or if the illness warrants such.

PARTICIPANT DEMEANOR: This is a family event intended to be educational and healthy fun for all. Foul language and threatening, dangerous or offensive behavior at any time during the event will not be tolerated and will result in automatic disqualification.

DISQUALIFICATION: Failure to follow race rules and guidelines will result in disqualification from the race and forfeiture of the registration fee. Disqualification of a team will be determined by the closest available Kiwanis Club official. All decisions are final.

PRIZES: Cash prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams that finish the course in the shortest amount of time. Both team members **MUST REPORT** to the final stop, step on the finish line mat and have their clue card verified by a Kiwanis Club official in order to be considered having finished the race. Clue card verification will include proper indication that all stops and tasks have been completed by **BOTH TEAM MEMBERS** and approved by a Kiwanis Club official.

CLOSING CEREMONIES: Closing ceremonies will be held at 2:00 pm. Any team that has not completed all stops by 2:00 pm should proceed to the final destination, Moon Lake at Idle Hour Park, for final check-in and participation in consolation prizes. Non-participants are welcome to attend closing ceremonies.
